### ~ MEETINGS / ACTIVITIES ~

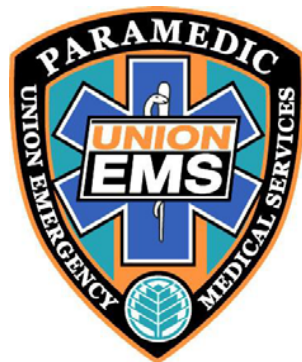

## STAR OF LIFE

The **Star of Life** is a blue, six-pointed star, outlined with a white border which features the Rod of Asclepius in the center, originally designed the U.S. National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) under the United States Department of Transportation. Internationally, it represents Emergency Medical Services (EMS) units and personnel.

The six branches of the star are symbols of the six main tasks executed by rescuers all through the emergency chain:
